Definitions			
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include companies with a Carson name; and financial companies such as Carson Group Investing, LLC and Carson Group Brokerage, LLC.		

Non-Affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. Non-affiliates we may share your information with include your advisor's new investment advisory firm and may also include financial institutions such as a broker dealer.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include financial institutions such as a broker dealer.
